Registrations for 21/22

We are now preparing for the new season to start in September, Surrey FA & leagues are requesting we affiliate and register our players in readiness for a September start. Therefore, we will open our registration process for next season shortly. You will be invited to register yourself/ your child with GSFC via Commentary Box (our online registration system).

We will amend or change our season accordingly to new guidelines when/if released from The FA/Government in connection with COVID but we are planning for a normal season.

All members are required to complete, supply and agree to:-

Membership Fees for 21/22

There will be no increases applied to the Membership fees this season, they will remain at the same rate as for 20/21. We shall however, be offering a discount to all Members who paid full fees for the 20/21 season (see table below). Members who did not pay in full or joined us following the lockdown will be requested to pay fees in full.

NEW FOR 21/22: Easter Camp will be included in the Membership fee this season.





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NEW for SEASON 21/22: Included in Membership fees, each member will be supplied with a reversible bib which must be taken to all training/match day sessions. Bibs should be named. Loss of bib will result in a charge being made for a replacement. This will ensure bibs are only used by 1 person per session and lessen our coaches load on equipment required for each session.

We will also be investigating investment into video performance equipment to help with player/team development.

Invoices will be raised via Commentary box for Membership fees directly after the Invite for registration has been issued.

Payment is required at time of registration either by via Commentary Box or via bank transfer amount stated below.

League registration will not take place until payment has been received.

Players will be ineligible to play for the Club or take part in any Club activities until membership conditions are met.

Membership fees are non-refundable.

Membership numbers will be limited in all age groups. Oversubscription of age groups will result in a waiting list.

Membership deadline: 30th July 2021. Places will be offered to those on the waiting list from this date forward.

Membership fees allow the Club to provide members with the following:

- A weekly training session with a Professionally qualified coach
- Eligibility to play in matches arranged for teams in their age group
- Game day coaching when available
- Pre-season training sessions (**fully paid up members only**)
- Futsal training sessions when available (Saturday sessions)

- Reversible bib
- All associated training and match equipment
- Injury prevention workshop
- Individual & team goal setting (psychology)
- Position specific training
- Specialised GK training sessions - weekly
- Training for club managers, coaches, and other volunteers including DBS checks
- Training ground and match pitch hire
- Affiliation with Surrey FA/Leagues/Insurances

Sibling discount – oldest child pays full fees, subsequent children apply 10% discount.

Payment plans to be agreed in advance with Club Sec/Treasurer (payment plans: fees in full are to be paid by 30/04/22). Discount will be applied to invoices following registration.

League player registration fees will be added to membership fee if applicable from 1.8.21. (Boys/mixed £5, Girls £7. Fees as set by each league).

Any member who has not paid their fees in full by 1st September 2021 will be unable to participate in training sessions and or league matches until such time as fees are paid in full.

Training :

Boys/Mixed: Training takes place every Saturday morning between 9am – 1pm – time schedule for age groups will be confirmed in September. Venue: Kings College School, South Way, Guildford GU2 8DU

Girls: Training: Monday evening between 5-8pm at Kings College School.

Ladies: Wednesday evenings 7-9pm at Kings College School.

PAN team: Sunday mornings 9.30-11am at Kings College School.

Players must arrive prior to or on time for their weekly session. They should be suitably dressed for the weather conditions. All clothing should be named, please note we do not operate a lost property collection, if garments are named they will find their way back to you.

All players must wear football boots, and shin pads at all times.

*Please note, footwear for Kings College 3G pitch will be strictly monitored, in accordance with their guarantee agreement. Players must wear football boots with plastic studs/ moulds whilst participating in training and or matches on the 3G pitch.

Players should bring their own drink for training sessions and match day (named container).

Parents are responsible for collection of players on time at the end of their session (junior section), due to quick turn around with age groups.

Matches are played Sunday mornings/afternoons at various locations – maps and directions for our home venues can be found on our website: www.guildfordsaints.org – find us. Teams will use Commentary Box to provide match day details and maps.





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Team Kit:

Teams identified for new kit this season, will be requested to purchase kit. The Club will not keep any stocks of the new kit, any replacements of kit (new style) will need to be ordered via our web site/kit manager. In the first instance we will take care of ordering full team kit. Should a sponsor be found for team kit, the kit will be supplied FOC to members (if full cost covered) or discounted by the amount of sponsorship received. Team Managers will be allocating players with shirt numbers, this number will remain with the player throughout his/her playing time at GSFC.

Who are we: GSFC is a grass roots football club run entirely by volunteers, providing training sessions together with Sunday league matches for boys and girls aged 6-18, plus an adult female team and PAN disability teams. Our main source of funding is the Club Membership fee which covers our day to day running of the club, our largest expense being Professional coaching fees and pitch hire. We actively seek sponsorship but this is not guaranteed income, we would love to hear from any potential sponsors of team kit.

We require volunteers to join us for the forthcoming season If you are able to take on Match day warm up/games or provide admin assistance to a team please contact me. Guidance and mentors available. Be InspiredGet involved.....make a difference...

Training courses can be provided to potential Team Managers, Coaches, Referees and Assist Referees. All volunteers are required to undertake a DBS check.

FOOTWEAR POLICY /SITE POLICY

EVERYONE entering the 3G pitch area is required to wear the correct footwear.

Only players, Managers & Coaches allowed on 3G – Home & Away teams

Please Remember you will **not be allowed** to use the 3G pitch without the correct clean footwear, please do not take offence if you are asked to leave the 3G area.

All footwear must be clean – NO muddy boots on the 3G as it damages the silicon pieces on the astro turf.

Football boots are the preferred footwear so you can use normal football boots but **NO METAL STUDS, astro turf boots or flat soled trainers.**

All adults 16+ entering Kings College premises must scan in using the NHS QR Code (downloadable app) Scan Codes found on railing around the 3G area.

WC's available in emergencies only.

NO dogs allowed on site.

Please take all belongings and rubbish home, or use bins provided.

Spectators must stay behind the green barrier/fencing.

Please leave the venue as soon as your session has finished.
