League player registration fees will be added to membership fee if applicable from 1.9.23. (Boys/mixed £5, Girls £6. Fees as set by each league, subject to change).

Sibling discount – oldest child pays full fees; subsequent children apply 10% discount. Payment plans to be agreed in advance with Club Sec/Treasurer (payment plans: fees in full are to be paid by 30/04/24). Applicable discount will be applied to invoices.

Invoices will be raised via Commentary box for Membership fees/bibs.

Payment is required at time of registration via Commentary Box.

League registration will not take place until payment has been received.

Membership fees are non-refundable.

Membership numbers will be limited in all age groups. Oversubscription of age groups will result in a waiting list or a training only group option if available.

Membership deadline: 14th August 2023. Places will be offered to those on the waiting list from this date forward.

Any member who has not paid their fees in full by 1st September 2023 or met registration conditions will be unable to participate in training sessions and or league matches until such time as fees are paid in full and registration is complete.

Players must arrive promptly for their training session and be suitably dressed for the weather conditions. Clothing should be named. We do not operate a lost property collection, if garments are named, they will find their way back to you.

All players must wear football boots, and shin pads at all times. Players should bring their own drink for training sessions and match day (named container).

Social Media & Mobile Phones:

Please be aware that we take a zero-tolerance approach to bullying via social media, whether messages are sent within GSFC or to players/officials outside of GSFC. All instances reported will be investigated and if deemed necessary membership of GSFC will be withdrawn.

Mobile Phones: should not be used during a training session unless in emergency situations.

Streaming Policy: players will be assessed throughout the season by our Director of Coaching, Pro Coaches and Team Managers. It may become evident that a player needs to move teams to further develop. This may mean moving up a level or moving down. Parents/players will be approached prior to any movement.

Footwear Policy for 3G pitches:

Clean, correct footwear must be worn (see below). Only players, managers and coaches allowed on the pitch. Please do not take offence if you/your child is asked to leave the 3G if you do not adhere to this request. Football boots are acceptable – NO metal studs, astro boots or flat soled shoes.
