## Code of Conduct 1/2

### Play your part: On and Off the field, I will:

- Have fun: it's what we're here for!
- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides.
- Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same.
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour, verbally or via social media.
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated spectator's area (where provided).
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time.
- Make every effort to abide by the rules and spirit of the game.
- Respect the facilities home and away.

### Guildford Saints expects Parents/Carers and Spectators to have the following obligations towards their children:-

- Abide by the decisions of the coach in relation to team selection and match play.
- Arrive/collect your child promptly for both training and matches.
- Provide appropriate clothing for the activity, having regard for both ground and weather conditions.
- Make myself familiar with Safeguarding practices and review guidance on physical contact (5.6) & Acceptable Behaviours when Working with Young People (5.7) documents on the Safeguarding Section of EnglandFootball.com.
- Always consider the general wellbeing of your child when taking part in any club activity.

Parents must register their child in advance to attend any football sessions, training or match day.
